On February 10, at the start of the E-world in Essen, management representatives of the energy industry gathered for the 14th SZ Leadership Meeting Energy. This platform offered the opportunity for groundbreaking discussions and intensive exchange on the most important challenges and opportunities of the energy transition.

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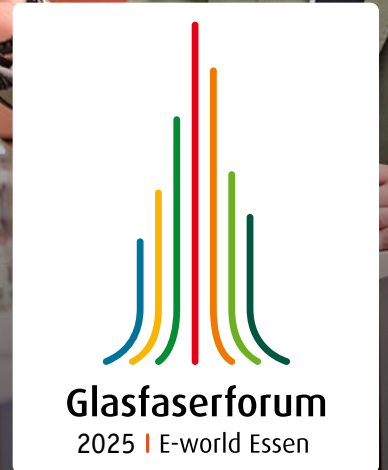

For the seventh time, the fiber optic forum offered players involved in fiber optic expansion in North Rhine-Westphalia the opportunity to analyse the current state of the market and discuss the measures required for nationwide expansion.

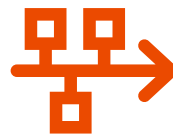

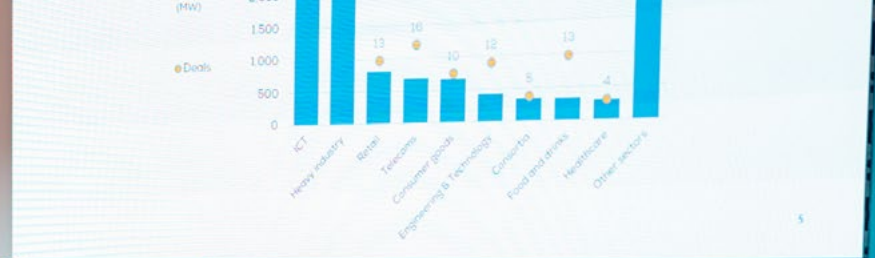
